Brooklyn School Home Zone

All students who live within the home zone described below shall be entitled to enrol at the school.

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From the intersection of Happy Valley Road and Ohiro Road to Polhill Trig (so as to include all of Kowhai Park and Panorama Heights subdivisions and to the west to also include Hawkins Hill Road and Southernthread Road) to the intersection of Mortimer Terrace and Laura Avenue (so as to include all of Karepa Street and Laura Avenue but to exclude all of Mortimer Terrace).

Then via Tanera Park to Ohiro Road via Central Park to the intersection of Bidwill Street and Brooklyn Road; along the southern side of Bidwill Street (so as to exclude all of Bidwill Street) to the intersection of Bell Road (so as to include all of Bell Road); then via the town belt to the intersection of Connaught Terrace and Pearce Street (Pearce Street 2-20A and 1 are in zone).

Then the scheme goes along Connaught Terrace to the intersection of Washington Avenue and Mills Road (so as to include all addresses on Connaught Terrace and Washington Avenue and to exclude all of Mills Road); then in a westerly direction to Ohiro Road (so as to include nos 1 to 39 (incl) and 2 to 40 (incl) of Mornington Road but to exclude all of Gowrie, Harland and Clarence Streets).

Then in a southerly direction along Ohiro Road (to include all of Ohiro Road, Butt Street, Borlase Street, Stock Street, Livingston Street and Rua Kai Way) to the intersection of Happy Valley Road and Ohiro Road. All dead-end streets of Ohiro Road are in zone

Proof of residence of a property within the home zone will be required (for example a copy of a utility bill with the name of a parent or guardian and an address within the home zone, covering the date of enrolment or earlier). Where a property has two or more entrances on different streets, or where the actual address of a property is in dispute, only the rateable address as recognised by the Wellington City Council will be considered to determine if the property is in or out of zone.

Special Programmes
